Home-School Agreement

Hagbourne CE Primary School will:

1. Encourage children to 'be the best they can be' in all aspects of school life.
2. Encourage children to take care of their surroundings and others around them.
3. Inform parents of their children's progress and behaviour at regular meetings.
4. Keep parents well informed of past, present and future events and news via newsletters and/or the website.
5. Encourage children to take opportunities which are given to them.
6. Provide a safe, accessible and stimulating environment underpinned by Christian values.
7. Provide opportunities for children to develop positive social relationships, self-esteem and a sense of responsibility.
8. Expect high standards of behaviour and work.
9. Ensure children are made aware that unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated.
10. Provide a full and balanced curriculum and strive to meet the needs of each child.
11. Encourage children to have regard for global citizenship.
12. Deal with any complaint in accordance with the procedure under Section 39 of the School Standards Framework 1998.

The family will:

1. Make sure children are ready for the start of school.
2. Make sure that a child attends regularly and provide an email, telephone call or note to explain any absence.

3. Make every effort to attend parent evenings and information meetings to discuss their child's progress.
4. Provide a quiet area for children to do their homework and ensure it is completed on time.
5. Make school aware of any concerns that might affect the child's work or behaviour as soon as they become apparent.
6. Make sure children are dressed in a named school uniform.
7. Not arrange to take holidays during term time.
8. Reinforce the reasons for respecting the school environment at all times.
9. Respect all members of the school community, abiding by their policy of zero tolerance towards rude or aggressive behaviour.
10. Support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any members of the school community.
11. Ensure children only have access to age-appropriate games and that devices are restricted (particularly overnight).

The child will:

1. Take good care of school equipment.
2. Wear the correct school uniform.
3. Follow our school rules by demonstrating they can be: caring, courageous, respectful and responsible.
4. Put in every effort to 'be the best that they can be'
5. Speak to an adult if they are concerned about anything.
6. Complete homework and give it in on time.
7. Look after our school environment.
