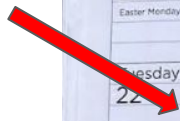

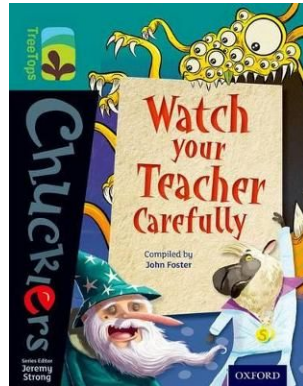
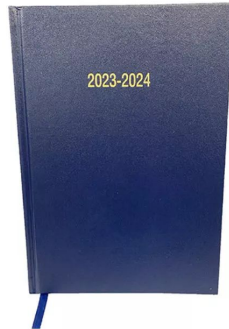
Spellings

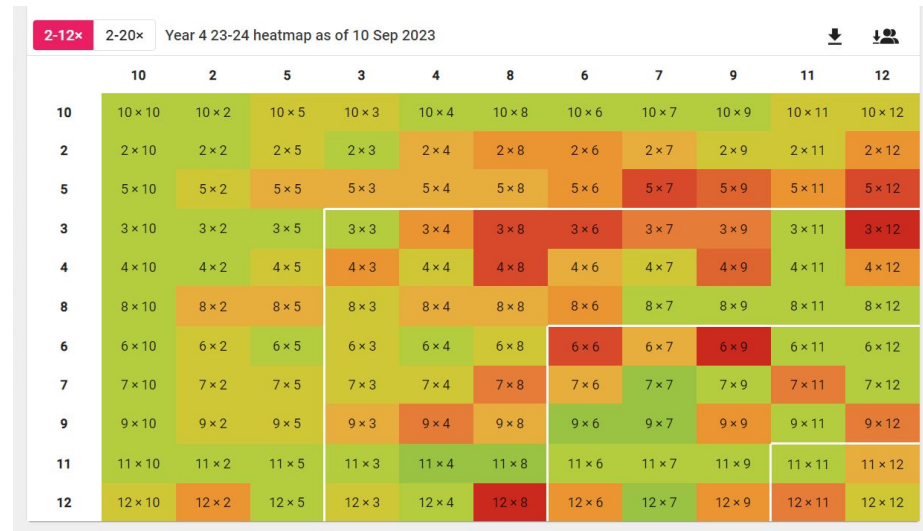
Times tables

The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is an assessment that the Government has introduced for all pupils in Year 4. It is an online assessment that has been designed to assess whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

By Year 3, children should be able to recall: 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s, and 8s.

We learn the rest in Year 4.
