### SATs

Tuesday 12 <sup>th</sup> May	English Reading Paper
Wednesday 13 <sup>th</sup> May	Maths Paper 1 - Arithmetic Maths Paper 2 - Reasoning
Thursday 14 <sup>th</sup> May	Maths Paper 3 - Reasoning
